Participants will be required to complete and submit medical history and liability release forms. The total cost of this five-day teacher institute is \$400, which includes lunches, field trip transportation, instructional materials, and three graduate credits from Michigan Technological University. For those who require on-campus housing, the cost is \$600 and also includes 4 nights lodging (Monday-Thursday) and all meals from Monday breakfast through Friday dinner. A grant from the National Science Foundation, along with a Michigan Tech School of Forest Resources & Environmental Science departmental tuition stipend, reduces the total course cost from \$1800 to only \$400 for both Michigan and out-of-state participants.
