Cost

\$600 includes room, meals, field trip transportation, instructional materials, and three graduate semester credits from Michigan Technological University for the 6-day Institute. (The total cost of the Institute is \$800, *plus* \$681 for MTU tuition. Support from the National Science Foundation, along with a departmental stipend, reduces the total participant cost to *only* \$600 for *both* Michigan and out-of-state participants).
