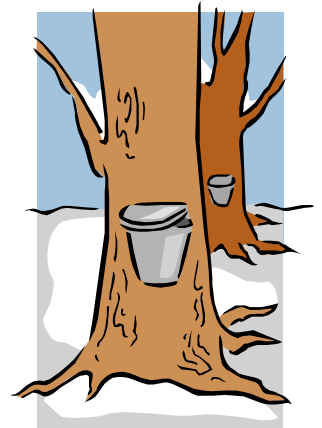


Science Scavenger Hunt
